- Head of the Political and Information Directorates of the Kosovo Liberation Army (KLA);
- Prime Minister of the Provisional Government of Kosovo (PGoK) and
- KLA Commander-in-Chief.

KADRI VESELI

Alleged position(s) during the period covered by the indictment:

- Member of the KLA Political Directorate and Head of the KLA intelligence services;
- Chief of the Kosovo Intelligence Service and PGoK Minister of the Intelligence Service.

REXHEP SELIMI

Alleged position(s) during the period covered by the indictment:

- Head of the KLA Operational Directorate;
- KLA Inspector General
- PGoK Minister of Public Order/Minister of Internal Affairs.

JAKUP KRASNIQI

Date of birth: 01/01/1951

Alleged position(s) during the period covered by the indictment:

- Member of the KLA Political Directorate and the official KLA spokesperson;
- KLA Deputy Commander;
- PGoK spokesperson.

Description of charges

The indictment states that the crimes charged were committed from at least March 1998 through September 1999 and took place in several locations across Kosovo as well as in Kukës and Cahan, in Northern Albania. They were allegedly committed by members of the KLA against hundreds of civilians and persons not taking part in hostilities. The indictment alleges that Thaçi, Veseli, Selimi and Krasnigi are individually criminally responsible, pursuant to various forms of criminal responsibility for crimes, which were committed in the context of a non-international armed conflict in Kosovo and were part of a widespread and systematic attack against persons suspected of being opposed to the KLA.

TIMELINE

Following their arrest by the Specialist Prosecutor, Thaçi, Veseli, Selimi and Krasniqi were transferred to the Detention Facilities of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers in The Hague on 4 and 5 November 2020.

During their initial appearances, held between 9 and 11 November 2020, all four accused pleaded not guilty to all counts of the initial indictment. Later, they also pleaded not guilty to the new charges in the amended indictment.

On 15 December 2022, the Pre-Trial Judge transmitted the case file to Trial Panel II.

The trial commenced on 3 April 2023 and the Prosecution case is ongoing.
